She has been active in the Latin American Coalition to End Violence Against Women, the Global African Congress, CKLN Community Radio, the Black Coalition for AIDS Prevention, and several other organizations.**

**On March 14th Maxwell was deported to Costa Rica. But the fight is not over!!!**
